In 1946, the MUCC Youth Camp was offered to boys only, ages 14 to 17 at Higgins Lake. The Michigan Department of Conservation (DOC) allowed campers to spend time with the DOC Foresters, Fish Biologists, Wildlife Specialists and Conservation Officers. From the original location at Higgins Lake, the camps location has changed over the years. Alumni may have attended when camp was hosted at Allegan State Park, Ludington State Park, Mill Lake, Proud Lake, or Ocqueoc Lake.

Since 2003, our camp has been hosted at the Cedar Lake Outdoor Center in Chelsea. While the last 80 years have brought location moves and program upgrades, one thing remains the same, and that is our mission to engage campers in Michigan's natural resources, teach them outdoor skills, and help them to develop a passion for conservation.
